For primary eligibility of the JV, eligibility of any one member of the JV which may not be the lead member would make the JV eligible to participate in the bid. For avoidance of doubt, any one member of the JV meeting the Clause 2.2.2.2 (ii) of the RFP document shall entitle the JV to participate in the bid and will be considered eligible for further evaluation. So, in effect the Clause 2.2.2.4 (ii) has been modified and the percentage requirement by the members of the JV has been removed.
